The Rockford Riverhawks are helping to save lives this summer. Rock River Valley Blood Center (RRVBC) announces that all donors that register to donate blood this summer (through August 31) will receive a voucher for admission to a Riverhawks, home game (vouchers good for Sun-Wed games).

As temperatures rise, so do high-risk activities and related injuries. "Recruiting donors is very challenging throughout the summer months. In order to maintain an adequate supply at all times, RRVBC looks to partners in the community like the Rockford Riverhawks," stated RRVBC Public Relations and Marketing Manager, Jennifer Bowman. "One in three of us will need blood. Last year, more than 5 million American lives were saved through blood transfusion. The Rock River Valley Blood Center is making every attempt to ensure that the community is given the opportunity to conveniently donate blood."

Donating blood is safe and simple. You are most likely able to donate if you are at least 17 years old (16 year olds may donate with parental consent), weigh at least 110 pounds and are in general good health. Persons taking medications are not necessarily disqualified.

The Rock River Valley Blood Center serves as a centralized, community blood center and is the sole provider of blood products and services to Beloit Health System, Edgerton Hospital and Health Services, Freeport Health Network, Mercy Harvard Hospital, OSF Saint Anthony Medical Center, Rochelle Community Hospital, Rockford Health System, SwedishAmerican Health System and SwedishAmerican Medical Center—Belvidere.
